

Metro's Current & Future Regional Network




- Coordination with Cooperating Agencies (US Environmental Protection Agency, US Army Corps of Engineers, Caltrans)

- Alignment Variation
 - SR 60 (north jog to avoid south parcel of OII Superfund site)
 - Washington Blvd. (East of Montebello Blvd)



Alternatives Variations



- Potential Maintenance Yard
 - 3 different locations within Study Area
 - Mission Junction, Los Angeles
 - West of Garfield Ave., Commerce
 - East of Allport Ave., Santa Fe Springs
 - One location identified in Monrovia (separate effort)

 - Climate Change






