Subject: Special Event Permit Application - Whittier Pride at the Park

RECOMMENDATION

Review and recommend approval of Whittier Pride Special Event Permit Application to host a Pride at the Park event at Central Park on Saturday, September 25, 2021.

BACKGROUND

In 2019 the City of Whittier received an application from the Whittier Youth Build organization to host a Whittier Pride Festival to be held at Central Park. On August 13, 2019, City Council approved the permit for the Whittier Youth Build, Whittier Pride Festival. The event was held on September 28, 2019 and was well received and attended by the surrounding community.

DISCUSSION

The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department has received a Special Event permit application from Whittier Pride to host Whittier Pride in the Park. Members from the 2019 event have formalized the organization and are now a newly formed non-profit, Whittier Pride. The permit is requesting to hold the event on Saturday, September 25, 2021, at Central Park. They have submitted the same event footprint as the 2019 Whittier Pride Festival. The Whittier Pride in the Park is again intended to celebrate diversity and provide community, fellowship, and resources for the LGBT+ people of Whittier and surrounding communities.

The event will be free and open to the public from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Park access has been requested from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. to allow sufficient time for set-up through clean-up. Anticipated attendance is approximately 2,000 people throughout the entire day. The committee plans to work with Whittier organizations, churches, businesses, and residents to create an event that is positive, uplifting, and mutually beneficial for all involved.

It is anticipated that Whittier Pride will have approximately 40 vendors, primarily consisting of local businesses with some regional and national companies. Also scheduled are two food trucks which will be parked along Bailey Street. All retail vendors are required to have a valid California Seller's Permit, and City of Whittier Business License; food vendors are also required to provide proof of a valid county

health certificate. Many local businesses and organizations have already expressed their support and interest in participating as vendors and/or sponsors.

Restroom facilities will be provided through a combination of the facilities existing at the park and the Whittier Pride Committees provision of portable restrooms in sufficient numbers to accommodate the anticipated attendance. The portable restrooms will not be placed on the park grounds.

Entertainment consisting of live bands, dancers, singers, comedians, magicians, cheerleaders, DJs, and other similar acts that will be staged in the gazebo area and a second stage placed in the park.

The "Family Fun Zone" will be an area designated for family-friendly activities such as carnival games, ring toss, and corn hole, as well as a fitness zone for yoga type activities. The event will also have a vaccination education area and other wellness activities and information.

The Whittier Pride Committee is requesting the closure of Bailey Street, between Friends Avenue and Washington Avenue with limited access to the perimeter of the park. This area will be for vendor loading and unloading as well as food truck parking. All street closure requirements, as determined by the Public Works Department and Whittier Police Department, will be followed.

Whittier Pride will pay the required fees for police and/or security personnel, street closures and park maintenance fees for the event. (Attachment B)

The Whittier Pride Committee has communicated with members of the community including residents, businesses, and organizations. They have been met with excitement and positive comments for the possible return of their event.

A valid Certificate of Insurance, with Endorsement, naming the City of Whittier as "Additional Insured", including City's required coverage limits, will be submitted to the Administrative Services Department for review no less than two (2) weeks prior to the proposed event.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this report. The applicant will pay for all City associated costs.


